





1. First way is to *Insert* a drawing



Insert a drawing:


Head over to the line options and select Scribble





Insert a drawing:


If you are on your computer you can use your mouse to create a signature, if you are on the iPad you can use your Apple pencil!



Once finished click the blue save and close button


Insert a drawing:

2. Second option is using an <u>Add-ons</u>






Add-ons:


Search for dotted signature. It should look like the picture below. Click the blue **+FREE** button.




Add-ons:

It will prompt you to choose an account. Then ask for you to allow it. Click the blue ALLOW button.







Add-ons:

You will have this dialogue box appear. You can go in & create your signature like before with your mouse. Click

save when you are finished.
